an outside agency to provide emotional support services to anyone who has been a victim of sexual assault or abuse **during or before** detention.

is required to protect people in their custody who report sexual abuse or harassment from retaliation by staff or detainees.

will:

- 1. Maintain communication via letter correspondence and hotline calls.
- 2. Provide ongoing Emotional Support Services related to Sexual Violence upon request.

If you would like to speak with someone about any incidents of sexual violence, or if someone you know has been impacted by an act of sexual violence, you may contact outside victim advocates for emotional support services by phone or mail.

is not a PREA

reporting line – Advocates at are trained in providing confidential emotional support to people impacted by sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
