02 | VALOR HOSTED THE 2021 NATIONAL SEXUAL ASSAULT CONFERENCE (NSAC)

Advancing Equity. Ending Sexual Violence" was the theme of the 2021 National Sexual Assault Conference (NSAC). Over 16,000 activists, advocates and other professionals working to prevent sexual violence from all 50 states and 12 other territories and countries including Albania, American Samoa, Bahamas, Canada, Guam, Kern, Nepal, Nigeria, Northern Mariana Islands, Philippines, Puerto Rico, and the United Kingdom attended on Zoom or Facebook Live. POLICY

In 2021 VALOR successfully advocated for California to fund \$15 million for sexual and domestic violence prevention and \$100 million for victim services filling the shortfall from the federal sources. #PreventionWorks

In 2021 VALOR actively advocated for funding for the Victims of Crime Act, which later resulted in the bill being passed nationally. VALOR will always be a voice for survivors as we lead the nation from California.
