Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center

Successes:

- We had a total of 55 parents attend the parent workshop
 - 25 parents attended in-person
 - 30 parents attended through zoom
- Parent engagement was highly successful with parents answering presentation questions and around 3-4 parents asked questions.
- Majority of parents bought their children with them which was highly suggested.
